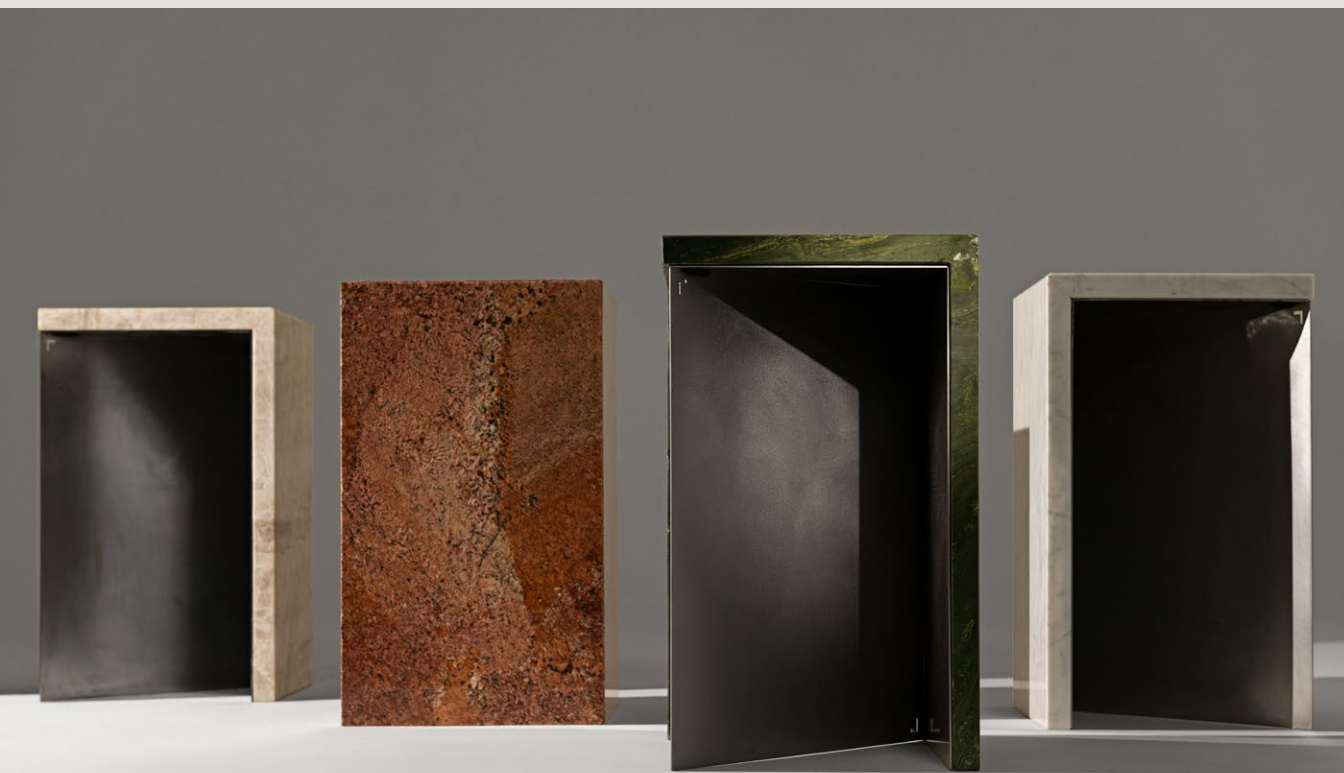
Architres Studio has unveiled its first product family, REBLE, which has already been nominated for the EDIDA, the prestigious design award of ELLE Decoration magazine Hungary. The designers of these timeless tables, made of marble and steel, offer elegant and innovative indoor furniture while also taking sustainability into account.



It has been a long-standing dream of Architres Studio to showcase their creativity and expertise through an independent product line alongside their interior design projects. The introductory series represents the vision of László Csizinszky, an interior designer, Dániel Kis, an architect, and their business partner, Johanna Bakcsy. The creators have a fondness for clean aesthetics and architectural approaches, aiming to create visually stunning yet understated interiors.



The designers wanted to create a table that would serve as a statement piece in any environment while incorporating sustainability into their design practice, in contrast to the excessive and environmentally damaging production practices often associated with luxury goods. As a result, they opted for using recycled materials: REBLE tables are crafted from unused marble remnants sourced from a domestic facility that would otherwise end up in landfill. Following meticulous selection and post-treatment, these remnants find new life in the tables of Architres Studio. This approach inspired the name of the collection, which combines the word „MARBLE” with „REUSE,” symbolizing a zero waste mindset, and also signifies the specific product (TABLE), while alluding to its innovative and rebellious (REBEL) design.



The interior accessories crafted from Taj Mahal, Carrara, Picasso, and Juparana Bordeaux marbles feature simple geometric structures, dynamically and visually lightened by the steel legs emerging elegantly from the hollow rectangular prism. „The resistant stone mantle was shaped by time, while the internal steel plate was shaped by man, and the contrast between the two materials simultaneously facilitates the creation of the object and generates a pleasant tension,” reveal the designers. Despite their minimalist approach, these objects emphasize versatility, as rotating the furniture by 180 degrees creates the illusion of a solid marble block.

The furniture pieces, which has already been nominated for the EDIDA, the prestigious design award of ELLE Decoration magazine Hungary, can find their place in any room. Whether as console and coffee tables in the living room or as bedside tables in the bedroom, they can also be imagined as architectural installations that can captivate visitors in offices, galleries, and showrooms. The REBLE series allows customization with marbles available in different colors, while the ambivalent harmony between the modern, industrial-inspired metal and the classic, luxurious marble makes them unforgettable additions to any style of space.
